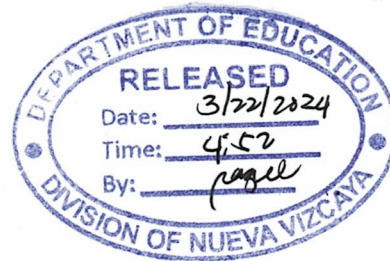
SUBJECT: **2024 GLOBAL IT CHALLENGE FOR YOUTH WITH DISABILITIES**

1. The Nueva Vizcaya Provincial Local Youth Development Office in coordination with the Persons with Disability Affairs Division will be conducting an IT Challenge for Youth with Disabilities on March 25, 2023 at 9:00A.M. The activity will take place at the Paniqui Hall, Capitol Compound, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya.
2. The purpose of this activity is to select the top four (4) representatives from our province who will advance to the national level. Additionally, the winners will receive the prizes at stake.
3. To participate in the activity, individuals must meet the following qualifications:
 - a. They must be Filipino citizens.;
 - b. They must be officially enrolled in high school.;
 - c. They must be between the ages 14 to 23.; and
 - d. They must have a disability, which includes being blind, deaf, having a learning or intellectual disability, or a physical disability.
4. Participants will be assessed on the following:
 - a. eLifemap (web browsing).: This test will evaluate participants' web browsing abilities.
 - b. eTool Excel: This assessment will measure participants' proficiency in using Microsoft Office productivity tool Excel.
 - c. eTool Powerpoint: This assessment will measure participants' proficiency in using Microsoft Office Productivity Tool Powerpoint.



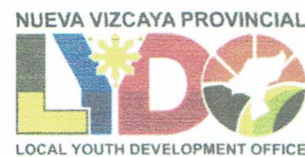
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5. Participants are not required to bring laptops or desktops for the activity as the DICT will provide the necessary equipment at the venue.
6. To ensure compliance with the zero disruption of classes, the teachers who will accompany the learners are requested to prepare their instructional plans. These plans should be attached to their travel order for approval.
7. The Office of the Governor will sponsor meals and snacks for the participants. Travel expenses, on the other hand, will be charged to the school MOOE, in accordance with the usual auditing rules and regulations.

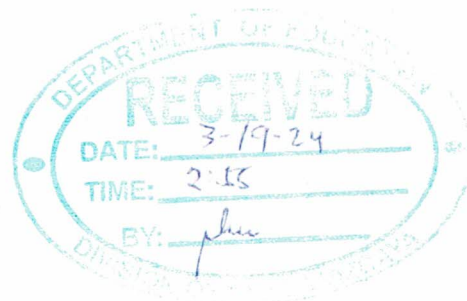
