PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

I. RATIONALE

The Region 02 Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking (RIACAT) will spearhead activities in celebration of the 2024 World Day Against Trafficking (WDAT) on July 30, 2024. This will be an opportune time for the Council to showcase its accomplishments and make known to the public its efforts against all forms of trafficking in the region.

In the said celebration, the Council also enjoins the support of the various member-agencies, consisting of both national government agencies in the region and other sectors who also play vital roles in the realization of the goals and aims of the Council.

The Council also finds it a strategic move to engage the youth in the region, particularly the academic community, by conducting a Photography Contest which shall be participated in by Senior High School and College students in the whole region. The Photography competition shall focus on its theme: FACES OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING. The Photography Contest will be another strategy to boost the dissemination of the Council's advocacy to wider audiences.

II. MECHANICS

- The Photography competition shall focus on its theme: FACES OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.
- 2. Each contestant may submit a maximum of three (3) entries.
- 3. There is no limit as to how many contestants may come from the same school or college.
- 4. Photos must be raw, in high resolution, taken using a professional camera or mobile phone.
- The post-processing of photos must only be limited to resizing/cropping and color enhancement. Photo manipulation is not allowed.
- Entries must be in digital JPEG or JPG Format (horizontal image or vertical image) and a maximum file size of 20MB (Preferably at least 150dpi or of a resolution able to be printed in an A4 size photo paper)
- 7. Photos must not contain date stamps or watermarks.
- Entries must not have been awarded in any photo contests and/or not commercially published.

- Contestants must ensure the safety of their subject/s, and must present any proof of consent from their subject/s for the public release of their photo.
- 10. Contestants are required to attend at least one (1) of the two (2) batches of online orientation meeting (see schedules below). Failure to attend will mean disqualification from joining the said contest.

VII. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

Impact and Message of the Photograph	30%
Artistic Value and Technical Excellence	30%
Originality	15%

VIII. NOTIFICATION AND AWARDING

Winners will be announced on July 30, 2024 in a face-to-face awarding ceremony. They shall also be notified via email and thru their contact numbers.

Winners will be receiving Certificates of Recognition and Cash Prizes.
