The Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), an attached agency of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), is going to conduct an online La Niña Forum for Northern Luzon on July 9, 2024 (8:30 AM – 12:00 NN), through the Climate Monitoring and Prediction Section (CLIMPS) of the Climatology and Agrometeorology Division (CAD) via zoom meeting platform.
