PARTICIPATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE 1ST NUVELCO QUIZ BEE CHALLENGE

- The Schools Division Office of Nueva Vizcaya in partnership with the Nueva Vizcaya Electric Cooperative informs all public and private secondary schools of the launching and first elimination round of the 1st NUVELCO Quiz Bee Challenge, "Empowering the Minds, Empowering the Youth" on August 23, 2024 to be held at the NUVELCO MCO Hall, Gabut, Dupax del Sur, Nueva Vizcaya.
- 2. To ensure compliance with the policy on "Zero Disruption of Classes", coaches with teaching loads are requested to prepare their Instructional Plans before the approval of their travel authority. However, it is strongly encouraged to consider offering advanced classes whenever feasible. If the teacher-coach is unable to accompany the contestants, school heads or department heads are eligible to serve as chaperons during the elimination round.
- 3. Likewise, secure Parental Consent from each of the learner-participants to be submitted to the partner agency on the day of the competition.
- 4. All participants are requested to pre-register via the registration link https://me-qr.com/ONrq7tSv on or before August 20, 2024.
- 5. Attached herewith are the Quiz Bee Mechanics and Guidelines, and Parental Consent to be used for the competition.
- 6. Meals and snacks shall be funded by the partner agency while traveling and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged to the division/school MOOE or any local funds subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

Objectives:

Enhance general knowledge and critical thinking skills among high school students.

- · Foster a spirit of healthy competition and teamwork.
- Increase awareness and engagement with NUVELCO among young people and the Department of Education (DepEd).

Partnership with DepEd:

- **Promotion & Participation:** DepEd will assist in promoting the quiz bee to secondary schools and facilitating learner participation.
- Test Questions: Questions will be developed jointly by DepEd and NUVELCO. Nuvelco shall invite local and provincial leaders who will serve as Quiz Master for every competition joined by NUVELCO and DepEd Representatives.
- Quiz Masters: DepEd will assign a qualified Quiz Master for each competition.
- **Logistics:** DepEd will cover transportation expenses for learners and coaches. NUVELCO will handle cash prizes and provide certificates of recognition.

General Rules:

1. Eligibility:

- Participants must be junior high school students (Grades 7-10) from public and private schools in Nueva Vizcaya.
 - Each school may send one team consisting of three students.

2. Registration:

3. Team Composition:

- Each team must consist of three members and one coach.
- Team members must be officially enrolled in the school they represent.

4. Dress Code:

- Participants must wear their school uniforms and School I.D during the competition.

5. Conduct:

- All participants are expected to display good sportsmanship and respect towards other teams, organizers, and officials.
 - Any form of cheating or misconduct will result in immediate disqualification.

Competition Format

1. Elimination Round:

- Ouestions: A total of 30 questions will be asked, including:
- 24 standard questions categorized by difficulty: Easy (1 point), Average (3 points), and Difficult (5 points).
- 6 Risk & Reward Questions, with their difficulty levels revealed only upon acceptance.
- o Procedure:
 - Teams will write their answers on provided paper. The difficulty level of each question will be announced before it is read.

2. Semi-Finals:

- Teams will compete in paired match-ups, with matchups determined by draw lots.
- There will be 15 questions in every game for the Semi-Finals Round. It would consist of 3 Easy, 3 Average, 3 Difficult and 3 Question from the Listeners/Callers and 3 risk and reward questions

3. Finals:

- Round 1: The top 8 teams with the highest scores will advance to the final round. Draw lots will determine their opponent.
- o Draw lots will determine their opponent.







- Question Format: 15 questions (3 easy, 3 average, 3 difficult) + 3 Risk & Reward questions (1 from each difficulty level) and 3 Questions from the Listeners/Callers.
- Round 2: Remaining Top 4
- Question Format: 20 questions (5 easy, 5 average, 5 difficult) + 5 Risk & Reward questions

4. Question and Answer Procedure:

 Questions will be read twice, and teams will write their answers on the provided paper. They shall be given five (15) seconds to write and present their answer.

Scoring and Prizes:

- Scoring: Points are awarded based on the difficulty of the questions answered correctly.
 - Easy: 1 pointAverage: 2 pointsDifficult: 3 points
 - Risk and Reward:
 - · Difficulty Levels and Points:
- Easy Risk & Reward Question: Worth 2 points.
- Average Risk & Reward Question: Worth 4 points.
- Difficult Risk & Reward Question: Worth 6 points.
- Penalty for Incorrect Answers:
- Easy Risk & Reward Question: -1 point.
- Average Risk & Reward Question: -2 points.
- Difficult Risk & Reward Question: -3 points
- Listener/Caller: 2 Points regardless of the Difficulty of the Question
- Tie-Breakers: Additional tie-breaker questions will be asked in the event of a tie and will be given 1 point each regardless of difficulty level.

Logistics and Other Provisions

1. Transportation:

- DepEd will cover transportation expenses for participants and coaches.

2. Appeals:

- Any disputes or appeals must be directed to the organizing committee immediately after the round. The committee's decision will be final.

3. Health and Safety:

- Participants are required to follow health and safety protocols as mandated by local authorities and the organizing committee.

4. Photography and Media:

- By participating, teams consent to being photographed and recorded for promotional and documentation purposes.
- Parent's Waiver of Consent will be given during the Elimination Round

Miscellaneous

1. Amendments:

- The organizing committee reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations if necessary. Any changes will be communicated promptly to all participating teams.







2. Disqualification:

- Failure to comply with the rules and regulations may result in disqualification. Schedule:
