TRAINING ORIENTATION-WORKSHOP ON THE FLEXIBLE LEARNING OPTIONS AMONG SCHOOL HEADS CUM DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL INITIATED INTERVENTION PROGRAM (SII)

- DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2019 stipulates the Policy Guidelines in the Implementation of K to 12 Basic education Program. Annex 3 of this Order provides guidelines on the Flexible Learning Options.
- Flexible Learning Options (FLOs) provide a menu of learning interventions and pathways that are responsive to the needs, context, circumstances, and diversity of learners. FLOs allow for variations in organization, approaches and modalities of teaching and learning.
- 3. The Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct a training-workshop on the Flexible Learning Option among School Heads cum Development of School Initiated Intervention on October 29, 2024 (First batch) and October 30, 2024 (Second Batch) at DepEd Conference Hall, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya.
- 4. The training workshop aims to a). identify learners who are at risk of droppingout; learners with special needs; children and youth who are out-of-school youths; learners in emergency situations; and learners who failed to finish basic education who are potential respondents of the Flexible Learning Option program (FLO); b). reorient instructional leaders on the implementation of Flexible Learning Options; and c). propose School Initiated Intervention to address the identified clients of the FLO.

- Participants are requested to bring data on learners' attendance (disaggregated by Grade Level for this school year) and data on drop-out in the previous school year as basis for crafting the School Initiated Intervention project.
