
**TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE ENHANCEMENT OF TEACHERS'  
COMPETENCIES ON CONTENT, PEDAGOGY AND DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES**

1. The Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST), outlined in DepEd Order NO. 42, s. 2017 establishes a clear career progression pathway for teachers. It underscores the significance of continuous professional development in pedagogy, content and digital technologies across various specializations.
2. Further reinforcing this commitment, DepEd Memorandum No. 1, s. 2020 focuses on executing professional development initiatives designed to enhance teachers' capabilities.
3. The Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct a live-in training-workshop on the enhancement of teachers' competencies on content, pedagogy and digital technologies for teachers in Filipino, Technology and Livelihood Education and MAPEH on October 17-19, 2024 on a venue to be identified in a separate memorandum.
4. The training workshop aims to a). provide training in innovative pedagogical approaches aligned with the latest educational trends of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers to enhance teaching quality; b). deepen teacher content knowledge of diverse learners needs through differentiated instruction ensuring learning opportunities for improved learning outcomes; and c). establish a supportive community of practice for collaborative reflection in support to the MATATAG curriculum.
5. Expenses to be incurred in this training workshop shall be charged against the 2024 SDO- HRTD Fund while the travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Participants are requested to bring laptop, extension wires and other data on the assigned learning area for the purpose of the workshop.
