#### DECLAMATION

## Mechanics

- The contest is open to all Grade 9 of Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya for S.Y 2024-2025.
- 2. Only ONE (1) entry is allowed for each High School.
- 3. The contest piece must be written in Filipino and shall submit 3 copies to the assigned TWG 1 hour before the contest proper.
- 4. The delivery of piece is 3-5 minutes.

## Criteria

- 1. Delivery (mastery, pronunciation, enunciation, and phrasing) = 30%
- 2. Content (relevance, choice of words, organization, and coherence) = 30%
- 3. Stage presence (expression, stance, gestures, background, and uniform) = 30%
- 4. Overall impact = 10%

TOTAL = 100%

### SPOKEN POETRY

#### **Mechanics**

- SPOKEN POETRY is a performance art that is word based. It is a writing that is
  meant to be spoken or delivered with emotions to an audience. It is an oral art
  that focuses on the art of word play, rhythm, improvisation, intonation and
  voice inflection.
- 2. The spoken word poetry piece must be an original composition.
- 3. The contest piece must be written in Filipino and shall submit 3 copies to the assigned TWG 1 hour before the contest proper.
- 4. The piece must be related to the theme and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
- 5. Each contestant is given 3-5 minutes to recite or deliver his/her piece.
- Sounds, instrumental or music background is allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.

#### Criteria

## a. Message/Content 40%

- 4. The content of the spoken piece is relevant and related to the theme.
- 5. The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.

## b. Delivery and Performance 40%

- 1. The spoken piece as delivered from the heart
- 2. Connection to the audience was established from the start.
- 3. Facial expression, hand and body gestures emphasized the different elements of the performance.
- 4. Enunciation is clear. Audience can understand what is being spoken
- 5. Words are pronounced distinctly and correctly. Does not stutter nor stammer.

## c. Originality 10%

The piece must be an original composition by the contestant.


## d. Overall Impact 10%
