The Philippine Commission on Women in collaboration with the Inter-Agency Council on Violence Against Women and their Children (IACVAWC), spearheads the 2024 Observance of the 18-day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW). The 18-day Campaign to End VAW in the Philippines aligns with the global 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence Campaign, which runs annually from November 25 (International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women) to December 10 (Human Rights Day). This global campaign began in 1991.

The 18-day campaign is anchored on Proclamation 1172, Series of 2006 declaring November 25 to December 12 of Every Year as the "18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women" and Republic Act (RA) No. 10398 declaring November 25 of Every Year as the "National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women and Children". The 2024 18-day Campaign to End VAW will center around the recurring six-year (2022-2027) theme, "UNITEd for a VAW-free Philippines," which is still aligned with the "UNITE by 2030 to End VAW" initiative of the UN, with its sub-theme, "VAW Bigyang-Wakas, Ngayon na ang-Oras!"

This activity aims to raise public awareness about the various forms and impact of VAW, while emphasizing that VAW is a public crime and encouraging safe, effective interventions in preventing and addressing VAW within their schools, and offices and to encourage DepEd Central Office, Regional Offices, Division Offices and Schools personnel to coordinate with the Philippine National Police for a comprehensive response to VAW within their schools and offices with strong focus on prevention; and

To empower women by disseminating information on available support services and resources, fostering a society that empowers them to uphold the Campaign to End Violence Against Women.

Further, it will be conducted in a hybrid setup on **04 December 2024** at the DepEd Central Office, Bulwagan ng Karunungan, and will be simultaneously livestreamed on the Official DepEd Facebook page.
