OBSERVANCE OF THE 18-DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN (VAW)

- 1. The DepEd Regional Office No. 02 will observe the 2024 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women from November 25 to December 12, 2024. This is in accordance with the government's commitment to ending violence against women (VAW) and the United Nations' "UNiTE by 2030 to End VAW" with the theme "VAW Bigyang Wakas, Ngayon na Ang Oras".
- 2. The 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women is an annual event intended to raise awareness about VAW and advocate for the complete eradication of all forms of violence against women and girls. It is a call to action for everyone to speak out against VAW and work together to build a safe and violence-free society.
- 3. Corollary, the Schools Division Offices and staff are urged to organize activities that are consistent with the general aims of the 18-day campaign, such as:
 - a. display of official Campaign banner in conspicuous places of their offices as well as their Online platforms: Display the official campaign banner in conspicuous places, such as the entrance, lobby, and bulletin boards.  - b. inclusion of All Women Cast Lupang Hinirang video to flag ceremonies.
 - c. online campaign participation and use of digital sticker packs: All employees are encouraged to participate in the online campaign by using the official hashtags #VAWBigyangWakas and #18DayCampaignToEndVAW in their social media posts;
 - d. development, Printing, and Distribution of advocacy materials on VAW-related laws especially for clients. Distribute advocacy materials on VAW-related laws, such as the Anti-Violence Against Women and Their Children Act (RA 9262), to their clients, such as students, parents, and community members. The advocacy materials can be in the form of brochures, flyers, posters, or infographics;
