Rationale:

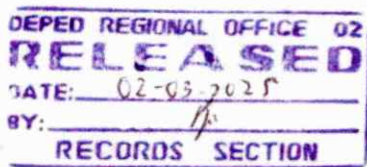

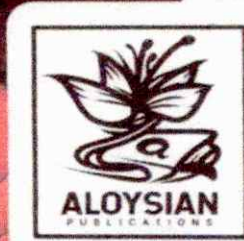
