In compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 417 "Declaring the Second Tuesday of February of Every Year as Safer Internet Day for Children [in the] Philippines," and in line with the promulgation of the Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11930, entitled "An Act Punishing Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Anti-Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM)," the Department of Education (DepEd) is mandated to ensure the implementation of anti-OSAEC and CSAEM policy in schools through its Learner Rights and Protection Division (LRPD).
