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

GUIDELINES FOR THE ACTIVITIES FOR THE CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH OF THE DIVISION FEDERATION SUPREME LEARNER GOVERNMENT OFFICERS TO ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS

ACTIVITY 1. DIGITAL POSLOGAN-MAKING ACTIVITY

GUIDELINES:

- 1. This activity is open to both public and private elementary and secondary school learners and is not a contested activity.
- 2. All SELG and SSLG Organizations in each school in the Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya (public or private) are tasked to lead and support this initiative.
- 3. Schools may submit an unlimited number of entries.
- 4. The posters must be digital and should reflect the **theme** "Babae sa Lahat ng Sektor, Aangat ang Bukas sa Bagong Pilipinas", focusing on women's empowerment and gender equality.
- 5. The poster must include relevant symbols, empowering messages, or quotes from inspirational women.
- 6. It must be created using digital tools such as Canva, Adobe Spark, or other creative software.

- 8. The deadline for submission is March 28, 2025.

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ACTIVITY 2. CHALK ART: "COLORING EQUALITY: WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT THROUGH ART"

GUIDELINES:

- 1. This activity is open for public and private elementary and secondary school learners.
- 2. All SELG and SSLG Organizations in each school in the Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya (public or private) are tasked to lead and support this initiative.
- 3. The chalk art activity will be implemented every **Friday** and during **free time** to avoid disrupting regular classes.
- 4. The chalk art will be created in safe, open outdoor areas such as school grounds or sidewalks.
- 5. If outdoor areas are limited, schools may be resourceful and use **blackboards** or any appropriate surfaces that can be used for chalk art, ensuring that it **does not damage or destroy school facilities**.
- 6. Create chalk art that reflects the theme "Babae sa Lahat ng Sektor, Aangat ang Bukas sa Bagong Pilipinas", focusing on women's empowerment and gender equality.
- 7. The art must be school-appropriate and align with the theme of Women's Month.
