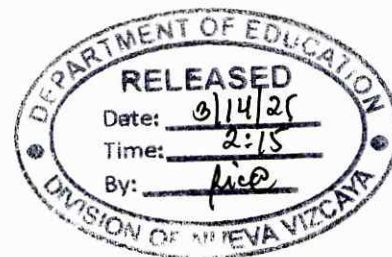

Since some of the training activities fall on school days , trainers and coaches who have teaching loads are directed to prepare their instructional plans and identify substitute teachers in the school who could teach on their behalf to avoid disruption of classes while attending to the activities.
4. Above are the activities with the identified trainers, coaches and critics from several schools of Nueva Vizcaya.

All SDO personnel and teacher-trainers/coach who rendered services during the conduct of the training activity on March 22, 29 and 30 (Saturdays) will be granted Service Credits /Compensatory Time-Off in accordance to DO 53 s.2003 ; for teachers and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No 2, 2002 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Record for non-teaching upon compliance to the needed requirements.
6. Expenses during the conduct of the intensive training, technical assistance, technical dry run/monitoring such as meals, snacks, transportation, accommodation, reproduction of training materials professional fees of Non DepEd trainers and other incidental expenses shall be charged to the 2025 PSEF for Read a Thon Festival of Talents (Filipino) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
