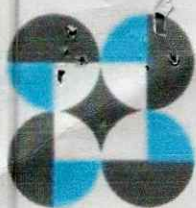

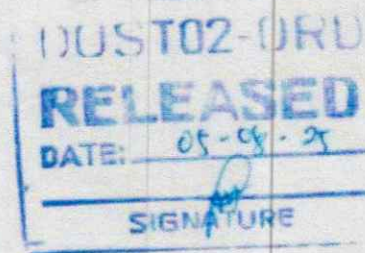

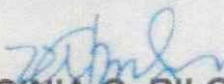

Junior Level Science
Scholarship Program

The program aims to provide scholarships for talented students in their **third year of college** and **who are pursuing degree programs in science and technology**.

It supports the country's aspiration to secure national progress through a new generation of empowered S&T professionals.

Types of Scholarship

The **DOST-SEI Merit Scholarship Program**, formerly known as the **NSDB** or **NSTA Scholarship** under **Republic Act No. 2067**, is awarded to students with high aptitude in Science and Mathematics who are willing to pursue careers in the fields of science and technology.

Republic Act No. 7687, also known as the **"Science and Technology Scholarship Act of 1994"**, provides scholarships to talented students whose family's socio-economic status does not exceed the set cut-off values of certain indicators. Qualifiers must pursue priority fields of study in the basic sciences, engineering, other applied sciences, and science and mathematics teaching.

Republic Act No. 10612 also known as the **"Fast-tracked S&T Scholarship Act of 2013"**, aims to strengthen the country's S&T education by fast-tracking graduates in the sciences, mathematics and engineering who shall teach science and mathematics in secondary schools.
