REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd) IN THE CONDUCT OF BRIGADA

ESKWELA FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025

This has reference to the online meeting on 16 April 2025 held with the Department of Education (DepEd) on the conduct of their annual *Brigada Eskwela* program nationwide regarding their participation in the Forests for Life: 5 Million Trees Program (FFL: 5MTP), and the signed Memorandum of Agreement between the Department and DepEd dated 21 March 2025 with the aim to: 1) strengthen environmental awareness and education; 2) support the National Greening Program; and 3) promote sustainable environmental practices.

The *Brigada Eskwela* program is an annual initiative by the DepEd together with the families and communities, local government units (LGUs), other National Government Agencies, the private and business sectors and other stakeholders with the objective to prepare the public schools before opening of classes, improve school facilities, and create a conducive environment for learning. Approximately 45,000 schools nationwide shall join the Program.

For the current year, the Program shall be conducted on 09-14 June 2025 with the regional kick-off events tentatively scheduled on 09 June 2025 with the theme: "Nagkakaisa para sa Handa at Ligtas na Balik Eskwela". The DepEd Central Office shall join the event of the DepEd Region V in a school located in Bacacay East, Albay.

The Program, through the kick-off event, aims to: 1) launch Brigada Eskwela for the year; 2) mobilize the stakeholders participating in the event; 3) promote awareness on community service; and 4) document best practices and improvement efforts. It also aims to integrate their national inventory day, maintenance week, tree planting, and a session on bullying prevention with the students' parents.

The kick-off program shall include the opening program, the launching of the national inventory day, a symbolic turn-over of donation from partners, presentation

of *Brigada Eskwela* model school, cleaning, repainting and minor repair of classrooms and vicinities, and tree planting, among others.

In this regard, this Office is requesting the DENR Regional Offices and their PENR and CENR Offices to provide assistance to the DepEd in the conduct of their *Brigada Eskwela* 2025, particularly in the following:

 Conduct of Regional Brigada Eskwela Kick-off Event. The DepEd is requesting participation of the DENR Regional and Field Offices in the conduct of their regional Brigada Eskwela kick-off events on 09 June 2025 at selected DepEd division offices and/or schools.

As mentioned, the DepEd Central Office shall join the DepEd Region V in the kick-off celebration. In this regard, DENR Region V is requested to provide technical assistance including provision of IEC materials, putting-up of DENR booth to showcase DENR's environmental initiatives, and lectures or talks about the environment and importance of tree planting.

For all the DENR Regional Offices. DepEd is also requesting participation of DENR personnel as volunteers for the *Brigada Eskwela*.

2. Provision of Seedlings for the School Beautification Activity. As part of the *Brigada Eskwela*. DepEd partners and volunteers shall conduct school grounds and infrastructure repair, renovation and improvement. This includes the planting of various ornamental and tree species. To support this activity, the DepEd is requesting the DENR field offices to provide seedlings to be planted during the week-long activities.

The species and number of seedlings shall depend on the site condition within schools, and the available space where trees can be planted. Please be advised that not all of the 45,000 schools nationwide shall conduct tree planting activities. The DENR field offices are requested to coordinate with the schools and conduct site visits to determine the species and number of seedlings to be provided.

In support of the FFL: 5MTP, the DENR shall provide seedlings of indigenous and native species only.

On the transportation of the seedlings to the planting sites/schools, the DepEd expressed that the same shall be shouldered by the DepEd divisions and/or schools.

3. Lecture and Demonstration on Tree Planting. As part of the technical assistance to be provided by the DENR, a lecture or demonstration on how to plant the trees shall be conducted prior to the actual tree planting. Discussions on proper care and maintenance of the trees after the planting activity is also requested by the DepEd. This includes watering, weeding/brushing, and installation of tree markers or tree guards, among others.

- 4. Documentation of Tree Planting Sites. As part of the FFL: 5MTP, all DENR field offices are hereby requested to document the tree planting activities including the species, the number of seedlings, and the area planted in hectares. Shapefiles of the area are also necessary for us to spatially document and monitor the accomplishments under this activity. A template marked as Annex A is included in this Memorandum.
- 5. Participation of DepEd in Environmental Programs. As agreed during the meeting on 16 April 2025, DepEd is interested in joining DENR's environmental programs and activities including but are not limited to the Arbor Day in June. Kindly coordinate with them once instructions or directives are given in relation to the said activity.
