



WAGI is Miriam College's advocacy center that promotes gender equality, women's empowerment, and gender-fair education. We offer a holistic perspective on women's empowerment interlinked with democracy, human rights, social justice, and value formation.

We are pleased to share with you our **Mid-Year Training for 2025:**

**1) Gender Fair Education (June 23-27, 2025, 5-day training) Registration Fee: Php 12,500**

The program is designed for educators and development practitioners (i.e. teachers, trainers, module writers, etc) in both formal and non-formal educational settings.

Gender Fair Education (GFE) is a foundational course on gender and development that introduces:

- ✔ **Gender and Development (GAD) fundamentals**
- ✔ **The power of Gender-Fair & Inclusive Language (GFIL)**
- ✔ **How to promote gender equity in education & training**
- ✔ **Practical strategies for inclusive teaching & development**

**2) International Women's Human Rights and Governance (June 30-July 4, 2025, 5-day training) Registration Fee: Php 12,500 (With optional study tour)**

The course critically examines the centrality of gender equality in international human rights instruments. It takes gender as a broad category denoting the diversity of human bodies and experiences related to identity, sexual orientation, age, class, race, ethnicity. These comprise intersectional and structural grounds of inequality and discrimination that result in human rights violation. IWHRG utilizes an interdisciplinary and practical approach to recognize the complex dynamics of gender equality and international human rights, and how to promote and enhance both in everyday life.



➔ **What You'll Gain:**

- ✔ Insights into **gender and intersectionality** in human rights
- ✔ Understanding of **structural inequalities & discrimination**
- ✔ Practical strategies to **promote gender equality** in governance
- ✔ Tools to advocate for **inclusive policies & everyday change**

**3) Gender Responsive Planning and Budgeting July 08-11, 2025 (4-day training) Registration Fee: Php 14,000**

The Gender and Development (GAD) budgeting process secures financial support for activities promoting gender equality and women's empowerment. Financial support, while necessary, must be complemented by strengthened organizational capacity for successful planning and implementation.

The course will provide:

- ✔ In-depth understanding of **Gender and Development (GAD) budgeting**
- ✔ Insights into key policies, including **PCW-NEDA-DBM Joint Circular No. 2022-01, Revised Guidelines for the Preparation of Annual GPB and AR to implement the Magna Carta of Women.**
- ✔ Practical strategies for **GAD planning & implementation**
- ✔ Hands-on learning through **case studies & real-world applications**

**4) Gender Sexuality, Student and Youth Wellbeing (July 22-25, 2025, 4-day training) Registration Fee: Php 11,000**

This course aims to provide inclusive spaces where every young person feels supported and empowered. This course is beneficial for teachers and school administrators, guidance counselors, social workers, and organizations interested in making a proactive support program for the youth.

Specifically, it will discuss the following:

- ✔ The intersection of **gender, sexuality, and youth well-being**
- ✔ How gender & sexuality impact **mental, physical, emotional, and social health**
- ✔ Strategies to foster **inclusive and supportive learning environments**
- ✔ Tools to develop **proactive youth support programs**

**All these courses are certified by the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW).**  
The courses offered are a week-long extensive program, which will be held on-site.
