Dr. Murray Print, a distinguished curriculum expert and Chair of Education at the University of Sydney, Australia, served as the keynote speaker. In addition to enlightening plenary sessions by experts, the conference featured panel discussions and 35 parallel paper presentations, delving into specific strands of curriculum history, curriculum planning, curriculum implementation, curriculum evaluation, and curriculum innovation. 

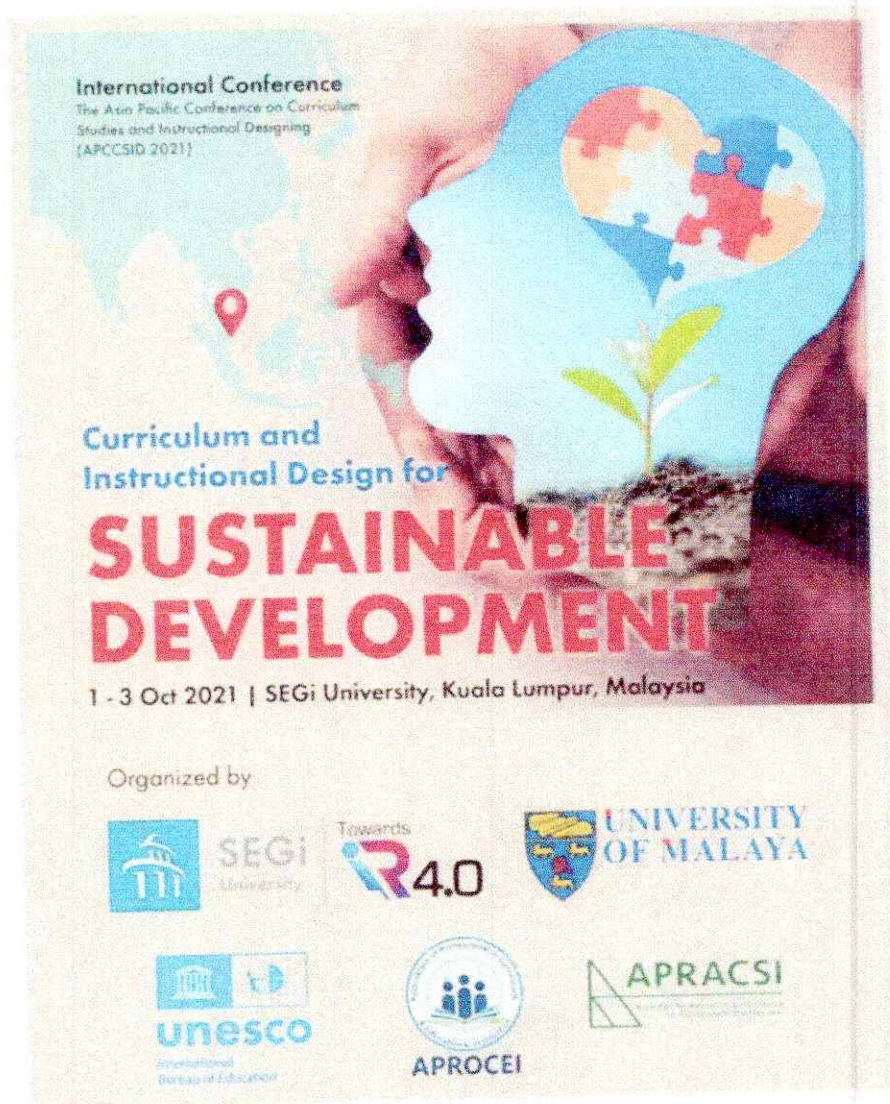

(APRACSI) collaborated with SEGi University in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, to organize the 2021 Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID) from October 1-3, 2021. This event marked another organizational milestone as it embraced a hybrid format for the first time, combining limited onsite participation in Malaysia with a broader online audience from across the Asia Pacific region. Themed "Curriculum and Instructional Design for Sustainable Development," the conference aimed to explore the roles and impact of curriculum studies in achieving sustainable development goals while fostering collaboration across the region. Ms. Stefania Giannini, UNESCO Assistant Director General for Education, graced the opening ceremony.
