



 a. Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID) 2017

Date: September 22-24, 2017

Venue: Crowne Plaza Hotel Galleria, Metro Manila, Philippines







The 2017 Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID) was the maiden conference of the Asia Pacific Research Association on Curriculum Studies Inc. (APRACSI). Held at Crowne Plaza Hotel Manila Galleria, Quezon City, Philippines on September 22-24, 2017, it focused on the theme, "Shaping the Future of Curriculum Studies: Policies, Perspectives, and Challenges." Dr. Murray Print, a distinguished curriculum expert and Chair of Education at the University of Sydney, Australia, served as the keynote speaker. In addition to enlightening plenary sessions by experts, the conference featured panel discussions and 35 parallel paper presentations, delving into specific strands of curriculum history, curriculum planning, curriculum implementation, curriculum evaluation, and curriculum innovation. The event also included concurrent interest activities such as a workshop on building curriculum for democracy and a roundtable discussion on security studies. The success of the first-ever APCCSID was evident in the participation of over 300 scholars, researchers, and educators from the Asia Pacific region, underscoring its significance as a pioneering and impactful academic gathering.

b. APCCSID 2018

Date: October 19-21, 2018

Venue: Crowne Plaza Hotel Galleria, Metro Manila, Philippines







The Asia Pacific Research Association on Curriculum Studies Inc. (APRACSI) successfully organized the 2018 Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID) at Crowne Plaza Hotel Manila Galleria, Quezon City, Philippines from October 29-31, 2018. Anchored on the theme "Program Evaluation and Educational Leadership: Innovations and Challenges," the conference aimed to tackle the ongoing wave of curricular and instructional reforms necessitating thorough evaluation. The first day featured three keynote speeches by esteemed experts, including Dr. Murray Print from the University of Sydney, Dr. Zongyi Deng from Nanyang Technological University of Singapore, and Dr. Richard Gonzales from the World Bank, along with plenary sessions. The second day of the conference highlighted four parallel symposia focusing on evaluation in basic education, teacher education, higher education, and security studies. The event concluded with 30 parallel paper presentations, a keynote speech by Dr. Andrew Wall from the University of Redlands, and additional plenary sessions. Notably, the second APCCSID mirrored the success of its inaugural conference, attracting over 300

scholars, researchers, and educators from the Asia Pacific region, establishing it as a noteworthy accomplishment in academic collaboration.

Date: July 26-28, 2019 Venue: Universiti Brunei Darussalam, Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam






For the first time in its organizational history, the 2019 Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID), inaugurated in the Philippines, found its hosting ground at Universiti Brunei Darussalam in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam on July 26-27, 2019. Organized by the Asia Pacific Research Association on Curriculum Studies Inc. (APRACSI), this third edition of the conference centered on the theme "[Re]Thinking Curriculum Design for the 21st Century." Dr. Andrew Wall from the University of Redlands, USA, served as the keynote speaker, delving into social and pedagogical trends and their interconnectedness with curriculum reform. Open forums provided a platform for fruitful scholarly discussions among curriculum experts and participants. The regular parallel presentations of carefully selected papers, aligned with the conference theme, further enriched the overall experience. Notably, the third APCCSID received recognition from Bruneian education authorities and garnered coverage on national television, underscoring its growing regional influence and collaborative ethos. This event marks the initiation of a journey for the conference to move across countries, marking a significant milestone in its regional influence and collaborative spirit.

d. APCCSID 2020

Date: February 25-26, 2025

Venue: ONLINE (Manila, Philippines)



In the midst of the global COVID-19 pandemic, the Asia Pacific Research Association on Curriculum Studies Inc. (APRACSI) and its affiliate organization, Curriculum Studies Association of the Philippines, Inc. (CSAPI), conducted the 2020 Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID) on February 25-26, 2021. Originally intended to take place in Thailand, the prevailing world circumstances prompted the APRACSI board members to shift the conference



to an online format. The conference centered around the theme "Curriculum Studies in Current Challenges: Designing for the Future," aiming to provide a platform for sharing and documenting innovative experiences in addressing the pandemic's challenges and shaping the new normal for curriculum studies. The distinguished keynote speaker for the event was Dr. Murray Print, a globally recognized expert in curriculum from the University of Sydney. Additionally, prominent plenary speakers included Dr. Andrew Wall from Redlands University, Dr. Zongyi Deng from University College London, Dr. Takuya Baba from Hiroshima University Japan, and Dr. Ng So Boon from SEGi University, Malaysia. The two-day conference featured panel discussions and parallel paper presentations, fostering a comprehensive exploration of current issues in curriculum studies and instructional designing.

e. APCCSID 2021

Venue: SEGi University, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia





The Asia Pacific Research Association on Curriculum Studies Inc. (APRACSI) collaborated with SEGi University in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, to organize the 2021 Asia Pacific Conference on Curriculum Studies and Instructional Designing (APCCSID) from October 1-3, 2021. This event marked another organizational milestone as it embraced a hybrid format for the first time, combining limited onsite participation in Malaysia with a broader online audience from across the Asia Pacific region. Themed "Curriculum and Instructional Design for Sustainable Development," the conference aimed to explore the roles and impact of curriculum studies in achieving sustainable development goals while fostering collaboration across the region. Ms. Stefania Giannini, UNESCO Assistant Director General for Education, graced the opening ceremony. Distinguished keynote speakers included Mr. Yao Ydo from UNESCO International Bureau of Education, Dr. Zongyi Deng from University College London, Dr. Murray Print from the University of Sydney. and Datuk Dr. Habibah Abdul Rahim from the Ministry of Education, Malaysia. The conference featured engaging plenary speeches by curriculum experts, alongside parallel paper presentations and a poster presentation competition, adding depth and diversity to the scholarly discourse.


