CAPACITY BUILDING ON MEA REPORTING AND L&D PROGRAM QUALITY ASSURANCE FOR STRENGTHENED SCHOOL GOVERNANCE

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisor, School Governance and Operations Division Chief Education Supervisor, Curriculum Implementation Division Public Schools District Supervisors/District In-Charge Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads School and District M&E Coordinators All others concerned

1. In support of the Department of Education's thrust to institutionalize quality assurance, accountability, and results-based management processes across governance levels, the Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya will conduct a technical assistance and capacity-building activity for designated School and District Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) Coordinators and Quality Assurance, Monitoring & Evaluation (QAME) Associates. This initiative operationalizes key provisions of DepEd Order Nos. 43 and 44, s. 2010 (Quality Assurance and Accountability Framework; Quality Management System), DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2022 (Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework or BEMEF), and DepEd Memorandum No. 44, s. 2023 (Interim Guidelines on the QA, M&E of NEAP Core Programs).

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QAME Associates. **Classroom Teachers are NOT allowed** to attend this technical assistance and capacity-building activity.

4. Participants are required to bring both printed and electronic (editable) copies (USB / cloud-ready) of the following, as applicable to their track. They must also ensure access to their School Drive (DepEd Google Workspace or Office 365 account) during the session for uploading, retrieving, or editing required files:

- ➢ For QAME L&D Track (Aug 26):
 - Evaluation data of responses from the participants (in MS Excel File)
 - Pre/Post Tests data from the L and D conducted (in ME Excel File)
- For Elementary MEA Track (Sept 2):
 - Latest School Report Cards (relevant indicators only).
 - School Operational Plans (AIP-WFP), School OPCR
 - Quarterly MEA submissions (Q1-Q3 2025 data if available; otherwise latest completed quarter) and accomplished School and District MEA KPI (The templates can be downloaded from https://sdonuevavizcaya.com/downloads/)
- For Secondary Schools/Integrated Schools MEA Track (Sept 5):
 - Same MEA data sets as above

All participants should bring a laptop with spreadsheet software (MS Excel or equivalent) and an extension cord. A stable, internet-enabled device is encouraged for accessing Project MAR and Project Quality TIME platforms, as well as their cloud-based files.
