



This is in relation to the ongoing initiative of the National Committee on Child and Youth Participation (NCCYP), specifically of the sub-working group composed of UNICEF Philippines, Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services - Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD); National Youth Commission (NYC), and Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), to develop a National Framework on Children and Youth Participation.

Recognizing the lack of comprehensive data on the state of child and youth participation in the country, UNICEF Philippines launches U-Report Poll, a survey that aims to gather insights to shape the development of the Framework and subsequent policies, programs, and activities for children and youth.


