

DIVISION TRAINING ON BASIC FOOD SAFETY (BFS) AND CANTEEN OPERATIONS FOR SBFP DISTRICT COORDINATORS, CANTEEN OPERATORS AND FOOD HANDLERS

2. The activity aims to:


- to enhance the knowledge and competencies in food safety management and school canteen operations of the participants;
