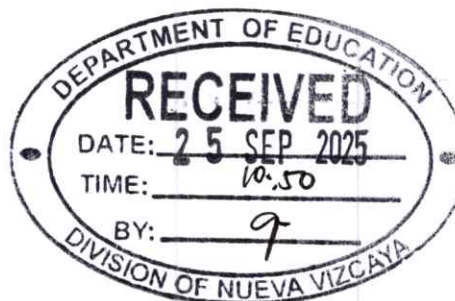

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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement which is made and entered into this 8th day of March 2022 at Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya, by and between:

The College of Teacher Education, Nueva Vizcaya State University (NVSU) -Bambang Campus, Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya, a government higher education institution committed to developing the full potentials of its clientele through quality and relevant instruction, research, extension, entrepreneurship, and cultural programs, represented herein by RUTH R. PADILLA, Officer-In-Charge, Office of the President, and hereinafter referred to as FIRST PARTY,

and

The Department of Education (DepEd), Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya represented by its Schools Division Superintendent, RACHEL R. LLANA, PhD, CESO V, with principal address at Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya, and hereinafter referred to as SECOND PARTY.

WITNESSETH:



WHEREAS, the main thrust of the FIRST PARTY as a state university is to equip the community through the delivery of knowledge and information, and to transfer technology for human development, and for a better quality of life for every Filipino.

WHEREAS, the abovementioned parties are entities undertaking various community development activities aimed at uplifting the quality of life in the rural/ urban areas;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned parties have the capability and resources to pursue, administer and manage comprehensive instruction, research, extension, entrepreneurship, and cultural programs either singly or alone and/or in cooperation or coordination with each other efficiently and effectively;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned parties are expected to produce better results, supplemented with the resources available of each agency;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned parties have agreed to synchronize efforts to empower the disadvantaged families, community, and sectors by developing their capabilities to undertake productive activities, gain access,



and manage the delivery of basic social services provided in the action plan of the College of Teacher Education as approved by the university.

WHEREAS, the abovementioned parties had come to an initial understanding that such collaborative effort should be formalized for a better working relationship with roles and responsibilities well defined;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, and as a mutual covenant, the abovementioned parties have agreed to work together on instruction, research, extension, entrepreneurship, and cultural programs, which include student internship under teaching-learning programs; **Tulong, Dunong, Sulong & Munting Paaralan Panghabang-buhay na Kaalaman Programs** under research, extension, and entrepreneurial programs which shall highlight projects along with the **Brigada Pagbasa Program**, Basic Education/Functional Literacy, Campus Journalism, Livelihood and Technical Services, Sports and Wellness, Research and Statistics, Gender and Development; and relevant cultural programs, with the following terms and conditions:

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY


1. Identify instruction, research, extension, entrepreneurial and cultural services through the Training and Assistance Needs Assessment Survey Questionnaire and through situational analysis;
2. Provide technical assistance and manpower in the implementation of instruction, research, extension, entrepreneurial and cultural programs;
3. Submit reports/documents on the implementation of the joint projects;
4. Share available resources and other things as may be needed in the development programs; and
5. Ensure that the coordinators/facilitators shall observe protocols and abide by all the rules and policies.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

1. Provide assistance to CTE - NVSU instruction, research, extension, entrepreneurial and cultural program coordinators, facilitators, and student-volunteers in organizing activities and clientele for productive and meaningful conduct of the program;
2. Designate officials for the security of the coordinators, facilitators, and volunteers, and supervise the implementation of the programs/activities; and
3. Provide assistance to any shortcomings in the implementation of the programs.

III. PROVISIONS COMMON TO BOTH PARTIES

1. Any modification to the foregoing provisions shall be made only upon the mutual consultation and agreement of the parties involved.



2. This agreement shall take effect upon its signing by the parties hereto and shall be binding for a period of five (5) years and renewable for another period at the option of the parties
3. Parties shall observe health protocols issued in relation to the pandemic.


