

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ADHD ONLINE TALENT FESTIVAL YEAR 4

Guidelines

- Open to learners diagnosed with ADHD who are currently enrolled in SPED Centers for school year 2025-2026.
- Each SPED Center shall be allowed only one (1) participant.
- Learners who have already participated in the Online Talent Festival in the previous years are no longer eligible to join, to give way to new participants.

Video Clip

 Each participant must prepare a 3-minute video clip with caption/audio description in landscape form and MP4 file format.

Talent Categories

- Performing arts (singing, dancing, acting)
- Visual arts (drawing, painting)
- Other unique talents

Submission

- Videoclip must be submitted on or before October 14, 2025 via e-mail @ pswdofocalpersons@gmail.com together with the learner's school ID and PWD ID, name, age and school
- Submitted videoclips will be posted online via Facebook on October 15, 2025 -October 29, 2025 for a two-week online voting.

Awards

- Entries will be ranked and the top three winners will be selected.
- Winners will receive a Certificate of Recognition and Cash Prizes.
- All non-winning participants will receive a Certificate of Appreciation and Consolation Prizes
- Announcements of winners and Awarding will be on the 28th of November during the Culminating Activity of National Children's Month Celebration 2025 at the CMP Convention Center.

Mechanics

- The services, products, and performances of participants will be judged by a panel of judges.
- The average score from the panel's evaluation will determine the ranking of participants.
- The decision of the panel of judges is final and irrevocable.

Criteria For Judging

- Creativity and Originality 15%
- Skill and Ability 25%
- Presentation and Delivery 25%
- Confidence 25%
- Audience Engagement 10%
