



#### 4TH REGIONAL PESPA CONGRESS CUM LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

To: School Division Superintendents All Others Concerned

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals' Association (PESPA) Region 02 in coordination with Regional Office No. II Human Resource Development Divisions-National Educators Academy of the Philippines (HRDD-NEAP) will hold the 4th Regional PESPA Congress Cum Learning and Development with the theme "Navigating New Horizons: Strengthening Leadership and Curriculum Innovation" at Hotel Supreme Convention Plaza, 111 Magsaysay Avenue, Baguio City on November 5-7, 2025.

#### The activity aims to:

- exhibit honesty, fairness, and accountability to develop a strong school culture that supports trust, respect, and high moral standards among staff and students;
- apply the new qualification criteria to accurately assess qualified candidates for Teacher IV-VII, Master Teacher III-V, and School Principal I-IV positions, ensuring alignment with the updated competency, education, training, experience, and eligibility requirements.
- develop and implement forward-thinking leadership strategies that promote innovation and align with a clear vision for transforming schools into dynamic learning environments responsive to future challenges.
- identify frequent legal difficulties faced by school principals and implement practical ways to maintain compliance with education legislation, protect student welfare, and reduce legal risks in school management; and
- create action plans and research-based solutions for particular educational or institutional difficulties, such as curriculum innovation and development;
- Participants in this activity are the PESPA Officers and Board Members,
   Principals, Head Teachers, Teacher-In-Charge, and Officer-in-Charge of Public Elementary Schools and School Heads of Integrated Schools. Attendance of participants is on OFFICIAL BUSINESS.
- 4. A registration fee of Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P7,800.00) shall be charged from each participant to cover meals, hotel accommodation, conference kits, venue, honorarium of speakers.
