In last year's IVMO 2024, over 10,000 students took part, with Mr. Glover noting that the Philippines contributed the majority of participants. What was not highlighted, however, is that our mathletes earned an impressive 541 gold, 970 silver, 1,515 bronze, and 3,002 merit awards—accounting for approximately 98% of all awards distributed.

We have recently concluded the **6th Philippine National Vedic Mathematics Olympiad**, the second of our national training events in preparation for IVMO 2025. However, we continue to rely on your support to broaden awareness and encourage more students and educators to engage in this global competition.

A Competition in Speed, Problem-Solving and Mathematical Acumen

1st October 2025

Dear Principal,

I wish to draw your attention to an exciting competition focusing on Vedic Maths. It is called the International Vedic Maths Olympiad and will be held next month across diverse countries. I would like to extend an invitation for students at your school/college to participate.

IVMO consists of one hour exam-like papers that test the ability and speed in using Vedic maths techniques and their application to problem-solving. Each paper has 40 questions. Students who do not know the Vedic techniques can still enter and do well. The competition is available in both online and offline mode.

Since its inception in 2021, IVMO has become increasingly popular. Last year there were over 10,000 participants and this year we are expecting in the region of 15,000. IVMO is particularly favoured in the Philippines from where most of participants come.

Dates and levels of entry are as follows:

Lower Primary	9 years and under	29 th November
Upper Primary	11 years and under	29 th November
Junior	13 years and under	29 th November
Intermediate	16 years and under	15 th November
Senior	18 years and under	15 th November
Open	No age limit	15 th November

The competition is run through Centre Coordinators and, should you be interested, then your school/college should appoint a member of staff to take on that responsibility.
