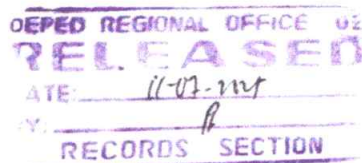

The Far Eastern University (FEU) and the Asian Journal on Perspectives in Education (AJPE) will hold the International Conference on Multiperspectives in Education (ICOME 2025), a fully online, free, and open-to-all conference on December 3–5, 2025.

ICOME 2025 convenes educators, researchers, leaders, and policy-makers to explore how Artificial Intelligence (AI) is reshaping teaching, learning, assessment, leadership, and equity. It aims to

1. equip participants with updated knowledge of how AI is transforming theory and practice in education;
2. introduce practical tools, strategies, and frameworks for applying AI in teaching, assessment, and institutional decision-making;
3. foster professional networks among educators and researchers engaging with AI in education; and
4. stimulate scholarly contributions through research and publication.
