Invitation to Hi-Lingua Online Exams and Grand Final in Frankfurt

Dear Students, Parents and Teachers,

We are delighted to warmly invite you to participate in the 2025-2026 Hi-Lingua Language Competition, a wonderful opportunity to demonstrate your language skills while connecting with learners from around the world!

This exciting competition features four language categories: English, Spanish, French and German. Whether you are a passionate language lover or just beginning your language journey, everyone has the chance to challenge themselves and prove their language skills.

The Hi-Lingua Language Competition is exclusively designed for students in grades 3 to 11 learning foreign languages, offering a unique challenge for language learners of all levels.

Beyond medals and certificates, participants will have the extraordinary chance to join the GRAND FINAL in iconic Frankfurt, Germany, often called the 'Mainhattan' of Europe, an experience full of inspiration, learning and unforgettable memories.

Join us and let your language skills open doors to unforgettable experiences!

Competition Rounds

The Hi-Lingua Language Competition consists of three exciting rounds:

- Semi-Final Round: Participants will compete online, testing their language skills through 40 engaging multiple-choice questions in each registered language category.
- Final Round: This round is more challenging and includes a video conference with the examiners, allowing participants to demonstrate their language fluency and comprehension in a more interactive setting.
- 3. Essay Challenge (FREE): This completely free category allows students in Grades 6 to 11 to demonstrate their English proficiency and writing skills. Participation in other categories or exam rounds is not required. Students can compete through this category independently, with the opportunity to earn medals and certificates.
- 4. **Grand Final Frankfurt:** All students who participated in the online exams are invited to the Grand Final in Frankfurt from 28 April to 3 May 2026.

Exam Conditions

Students will take the exams online through the Hi-Lingua Student Portal. It is mandatory to take the exam on a laptop or desktop computer with an active camera, either built-in or external.

Hi-Lingua exams in all 4 language categories consist of 3 grade groups in the Semi-Final Round:

GROUP 1 > Grades 3, 4, 5

GROUP 2 > Grades 6, 7, 8

GROUP 3 > Grades 9, 10, 11

The top 10 students in each grade group and language category will qualify for the Final Round based on the results of the Semi-Final Round exams.

Medals, Certificates and Awards

The top 3 students in each grade group and language category, including the Essay Challenge, in the Semi-Final and Final Rounds (78 students in total) will receive medals and certificates by mail.

The top 3 students from grades 3 to 11 (36 participants in total) in the Final Round will also be eligible for a discounted participation in the Grand Final Program in Frankfurt, Germany.

All participants will receive either a certificate of participation or a certificate of achievement.
