1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) Northern Luzon Region shall conduct the **Regional Adventure Camp** at Zoobic Forest Adventure Park, Subic Bay Freeport Zone, Subic, Zambales, on March 7–8, 2026 (Saturday–Sunday).
2. The Regional Adventure Camp aims to promote teamwork, leadership, camaraderie, environmental awareness, and personal growth through a range of outdoor and experiential learning activities that strengthen the values and skills of young Girl Scouts.
3. The activity is open to **Junior Girl Scouts (Grades 4–6)** and **Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts (Grades 7–12)** from the Cagayan Valley Region, together with their respective Troop Leaders (Teachers/Adult Chaperons).
4. Participation in this activity shall be **voluntary** and subject to existing DepEd rules and regulations on off-campus activities, including the submission of parental consent, medical clearance (if necessary), and compliance with safety and child protection policies.
5. Attached is the letter request of the Regional Executive Director and the Regional Chairperson of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Northeastern Luzon Region, dated February 9, 2026, for your perusal.
6. Travel expenses and other allowable expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to its availability and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Please observe the **no disruption of classes policy** as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005.








