

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DPO-2026-006 issued by the Department of Education (DepEd) Central Office through the Data Privacy Office regarding the submission of the Annual Security Incident Report to the National Privacy Commission, and Memorandum DPO-2026-007 on School-Level Reporting of Personal Data Breaches, this Office hereby reiterates the guidelines on reporting security incidents and personal data breaches.

All personnel who experienced any security incident and/or personal data breach within the reporting period are required to accomplish the online reporting form through the link provided by the ICT Unit: <https://forms.office.com/r/rY5YMSddDg>, submission shall be made on or before **5:00 PM of 05 March 2026** to allow validation prior to final submission to the Central Office.
3. Personnel who have no occurrence of security incident and/or personal data breach are not required to accomplish the online form.

In compliance with the National Privacy Commission's (NPC) directive for the submission of the 2025 Annual Security Incident Report (ASIR), the DepEd, through the Data Privacy Office, is compiling all security incidents and personal data breaches in the Department that occurred **from 01 January 2025 to 31 December 2025**.

For reference, *personal data breach* refers to "a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to, personal data transmitted, stored, or otherwise processed"<sup>1</sup> while a *security incident* is "an event or occurrence that affects or tends to affect data protection, or may compromise the availability, integrity and confidentiality of personal data. It includes incidents that would result to a personal data breach, if not for safeguards that have been put in place."<sup>2</sup>

Please be advised that the ASIR requires disclosure of all security incidents and personal data breaches, including those not covered by the mandatory notification requirement under the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Data Privacy Act of 2012.

For your guidance, security incidents and personal data breaches covered by the mandatory notification requirements include:

- a) Situations involving sensitive personal information or any other information that may, under the circumstances, be used to enable identity fraud;
- b) Situations where there is reason to believe that the information may have been acquired by an unauthorized person; and
- c) Situations where the Department or the NPC believes that such unauthorized acquisition is likely to give rise to a real risk of serious harm to any affected data subject.<sup>3</sup>

This Office requests all offices of this Department to accomplish <https://tinyurl.com/2025-DepEd-ASIR-Submission> on or before **05:00 PM** of **06 March 2026**.

In case an office has no occurrence of a security incident and/or personal data breach, kindly indicate “no incident” or “no personal data breach” on the form.

For your reference, please find attached a copy of the ASIR template which this Office will subsequently submit to the NPC.
