PHASE 1 PROGRAM UPDATES

The advisory pertains to **DM OULS-2026-090**, with the subject **Guidelines on the Conduct of the National Assessment for School Heads (NASH) Professional Development Intervention (PDI)** dated March 06, 2026.

Following an appreciation to the Domain-based Synchronous Learning Sessions on April 20, 2026, and 27, 2026, the NEAP Central Office has acknowledged the requests of participants who were unable to attend, finish the session or accomplish attendance and post-evaluation forms. In response to these concerns, an effort is being made to provide an opportunity for full compliance and completion. The items are as follows:

- a. **Training Resource Materials:** Dissemination of slide decks and Session Master Excerpts and Session Recordings
- b. **Domain Short Assessments:** Participants must complete a short assessment for their respective missed domains.
- c. **Attendance and Evaluation Forms:** Upon viewing the recordings and completing the assessments, participants must accomplish the forms to officially document their compliance.

To provide ample time for completion, the deadline for all Phase 1 requirements is hereby extended to **May 15, 2026**.

The **Phase 1 Assessment** will open on **April 30, 2026**, and will close on **May 15, 2026 (5:00 p.m.)**. Please note the following guidelines:

- a. Participants shall take and pass the centrally administered domain-based assessments.
- b. A passing score of at least seventy percent (70%) shall be a prerequisite for progression to Phase 2.
- c. Participants who do not meet the passing score on their attempt shall be allowed one (1) re-attempt.
- d. Should the participant fail to meet the required score, they must attempt the next domain short assessment immediately with the Office of the National Education Academy (ONEA) and the National Education Academy (NEA) to ensure compliance with the required score.

 - c) Participants who do not meet the passing score on their initial attempt shall be allowed one (1) reattempt.
 - d) Should the participant fail to meet the required score after the second attempt, the participant shall formally coordinate with the Schools Division Office (SDO) focal unit, which shall endorse the case to NEAP Central Office for appropriate academic or technical support and guidance.
5. To prepare for Phase 2: Practice Phase (Job-Embedded Learning), RO and SDO must ensure that each participant is assigned to a coach who is best fit to provide support in understanding the identified PPSSH domain gap(s). 6. Moreover, NEAP Central Office shall conduct the Orientation of Coaches to present the objectives of the program and introduce the toolkit that they will use for their coaching journey.
