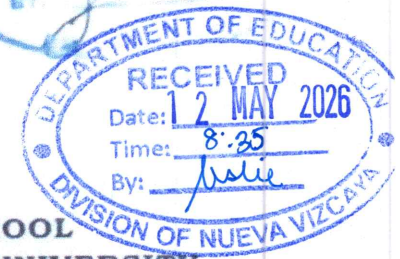

The Department of Education (DepEd) - External Partnerships Service (EPS), respectfully informs all Regional Directors (RDs) of the implementation of the Career Guidance and School Articulation Activities of the National University Philippines (NU) in identified DepEd Regional and Schools Division Offices nationwide, pursuant to the approved Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the NU.

This initiative aims to provide structured career guidance sessions, as well as orientation on available degree programs and scholarship opportunities, for Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) learners for Academic Year 2027-2028. The activities may be conducted either face-to-face or online, in coordination with school heads and guidance personnel, and are designed to complement existing school-based programs without disrupting regular instructional time.

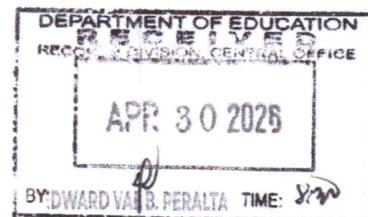


