1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2026, titled "Foundational Guidelines on Artificial Intelligence in Basic Education," the Department of Education continues to strengthen professional development efforts aimed at enhancing and upskilling educators. Amid the rapid advancements in technology, particularly in Artificial Intelligence (AI) and digitalization within the educational landscape, there is a growing need to support the integration of AI tools in teaching and to promote AI literacy among educators. These efforts aim to encourage pedagogically sound practices that enhance teaching effectiveness and enable meaningful transfer of knowledge and skills to learners.
2. In line with this, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in collaboration with Canva Philippines, will conduct **Teaching with Impact: Using Canva Education and AI to Transform Learning**, on June 27 and July 04, 2026, via Microsoft Teams. This 2-day program aims to equip the teachers with Canva and AI-enhanced digital skills to create engaging, interactive, and student-centered learning materials that improve teaching effectiveness and learner outcomes.
3. To ensure full compliance, all Regional Offices are requested to disseminate their respective regional links to each Schools Division Office (SDO) and ensure that every SDO endorses a total of 45 participants. These participants shall be teachers across all learning areas who have not yet attended any NEAP-related programs.
