**5TH REGIONAL PESPA CONGRESS CUM LEARNING
AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM**

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals' Association (PESPA) Region 02 in coordination with Regional Office No. II Human Resource Development Divisions-National Educators Academy of the Philippines (HRDD-NEAP) will hold the **5th Regional PESPA Congress Cum Learning and Development** with the theme "*Leading the Transitions, Empowering School Leaders for Effective Three-Term Education*" at **Hotel Supreme Convention Plaza, 117 Magsaysay Avenue, Baguio City** on **September 1-3, 2026**.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. foster a strong school culture of trust, respect, and high moral standards by exhibiting and institutionalizing honesty, fairness, and accountability among all staff and learners;
- b. equip school heads with advanced instructional and educational leadership competencies to effectively optimize school operations, streamline administrative systems, and drive strategic curriculum implementation;
- c. develop forward-thinking leadership strategies and innovations aligned with a clear institutional vision to transform schools into dynamic, resilient learning environments;
- d. address frequent legal difficulties in school management by implementing proactive, practical compliance measures that protect learner welfare and mitigate institutional risks; and
- e. formulate action plans and research-based solutions tailored to specific institutional challenges, with an emphasis on continuous curriculum innovation and school development.

3. Participants in this activity are the PESPA officers and board members, principals, head teachers, teachers-in-charge, officers-in-charge of public elementary schools, school heads of integrated schools, master teachers, teachers with potential to become school heads, and principal test passers without school assignments. The attendance of all participants, as well as the participation of the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) and the Assistant

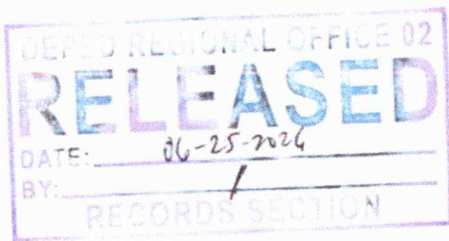

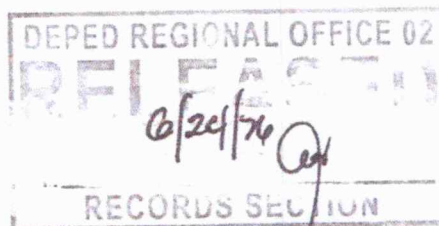
