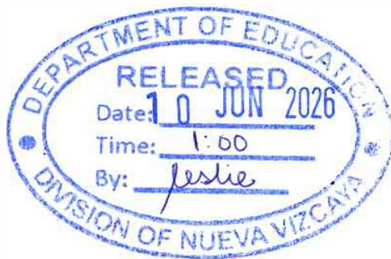

6. For information, guidance and strict compliance.



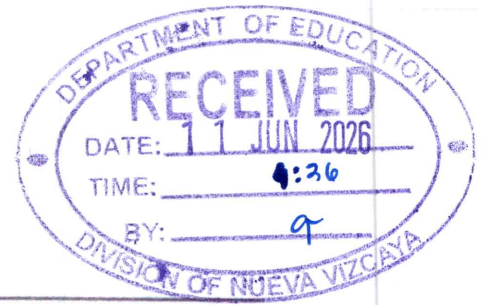

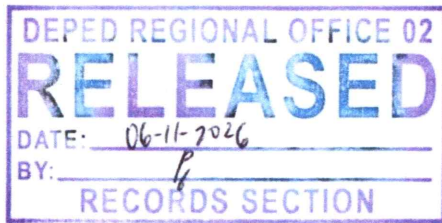
