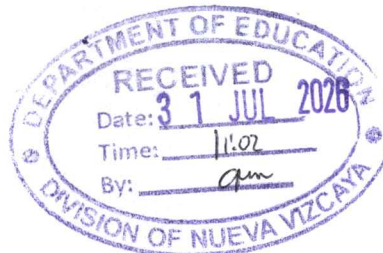

Building Safe and Compassionate Schools: Values Formation as a Shield Against Violence

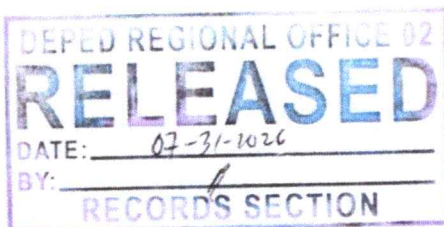
Theme: *From Fear to Empathy: Strengthening Values Formation in light with biblical principles to Prevent School Violence and Promote Peace*
