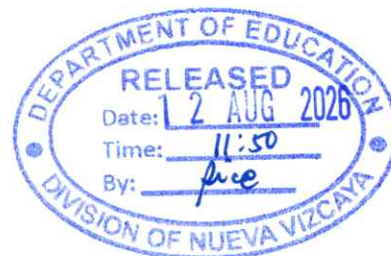

To ensure the uninterrupted delivery of school operations and services, all participating school heads are directed to officially designate an Officer-in-Charge (OIC) for the duration of their attendance in the training. Likewise, all school activities and urgent concerns shall also be appropriately managed.

Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged to the division MOOE for division-based participants. While expenses of school-based participants shall be charged to school MOOE or any other local funds, subject to usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations. However, meals and accommodation at the UP Hostel shall be charged to the sponsoring agency.

Greetings from the UP National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development!

The University of the Philippines has partnered with the Korea National University of Education (KNUE) for the UNESCO UNITWIN Network for Quality Teacher Education. As part of the partnership, KNUE, the UP College of Education, and the UP National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development are co-organizing a two-day professional development workshop entitled "**Modeling a Sustainable Future: An Integrated STEM and Digital Approach to Climate Action**".
