PARTICIPATION OF THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OF NUEVA VIZCAYA IN HANDOG NG PANGULO 2026 THROUGH THE DEPED SDO NUEVA VIZCAYA SCHOOL HEALTH CLINIC YAKAP CARAVAN

1. In line with the Department of Education Memorandum dated August 27, 2026 on **Handog ng Pangulo 2026**, the Schools Division Office of Nueva Vizcaya shall participate in the nationwide activity on **September 14, 2026 at Bayombong South Elementary School** through the **DepEd SDO Nueva Vizcaya School Health Clinic YAKAP Caravan**, in partnership with PhilHealth and other government and private stakeholders.

2. The activity shall target approximately **350 beneficiaries**, as follows:

Beneficiary	Target
Parents	150
Learners	150
Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel	50
TOTAL	350

Other eligible members of the school community may be accommodated subject to capacity and applicable program guidelines.

3. The following services and assistance shall be provided, subject to applicable guidelines and availability:

a. PhilHealth and DepEd SDO NV School Health Clinic

- YAKAP registration, empanelment, membership updating, First Patient Encounter, and GAMOT dispensing;
- Free medical consultation and health counseling;
- Laboratory screening, including Urinalysis, Lipid Profile, Fasting Blood Sugar, Hemoglobin, and Uric Acid; and
- Free medicines and other appropriate health services.

b. Partner Agencies and Stakeholders

- DENR** – fruit-bearing seedlings for parents;
- Department of Agriculture** – vegetable seeds for parents;
- Sierra Madre Amaranth** – health kits for Kindergarten learners;
- LGU Villaverde** – additional reusable tumblers for Kindergarten learners; and



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- e) **Nueva Vizcaya-Ifugao Dental Chapter** – dental services and provision of toothbrushes and toothpaste for Grades 2–6 learners.

4. The School Health and Nutrition Unit (SHNU) shall lead the coordination and implementation of the activity with PhilHealth, Bayombong South Elementary School, participating agencies, and other partners. The host school shall assist in beneficiary mobilization, scheduling, venue preparation, logistical requirements, and orderly flow of participants.

5. Participation and availment of services shall be voluntary and subject to applicable DepEd, PhilHealth, and partner-agency guidelines.

6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are directed.

In line with the directive from the Office of the President and the Department of Education's support for the nationwide initiative **Handog ng Pangulo**, all regional offices (ROs), in partnership with **PhilHealth and the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)**, shall facilitate **YAKAP Program activities** in **one school nearest to the provincial capitol** within their respective jurisdictions on **September 14, 2026**.

As the activity is scheduled during the wellness break, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, or the Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education, participation in the activity and availing of the services shall be **voluntary**. The services shall be made available to **learners, teachers, parents, other members of the school community, and other school personnel residing near the YAKAP Clinic who may be invited to the event**.

The Homeroom Parent-Teacher Association and the school Parents-Teachers Association may also be engaged to provide additional support or manpower during the conduct of the activity, as appropriate.

For the said event, the following services shall be made available during the activity:

- Generation of PhilHealth Identification Number and issuance of PhilHealth ID and Member Data Record;
- Assignment of beneficiaries to a YAKAP Clinic and PhilHealth Check Utility validation;
- YAKAP Empanelment, including the First Patient Encounter and issuance of the YAKAP Empanelment Slip;
- GAMOT dispensing; and
- PSA co-location services for National ID registration.

The ROs shall ensure proper coordination with the concerned **schools division offices, PhilHealth, PSA, and other relevant stakeholders** to facilitate the smooth, orderly, and meaningful conduct of the activity. They shall likewise ensure compliance with existing DepEd policies and guidelines, particularly those pertaining to the wellness break and the continuity of teaching and learning.
