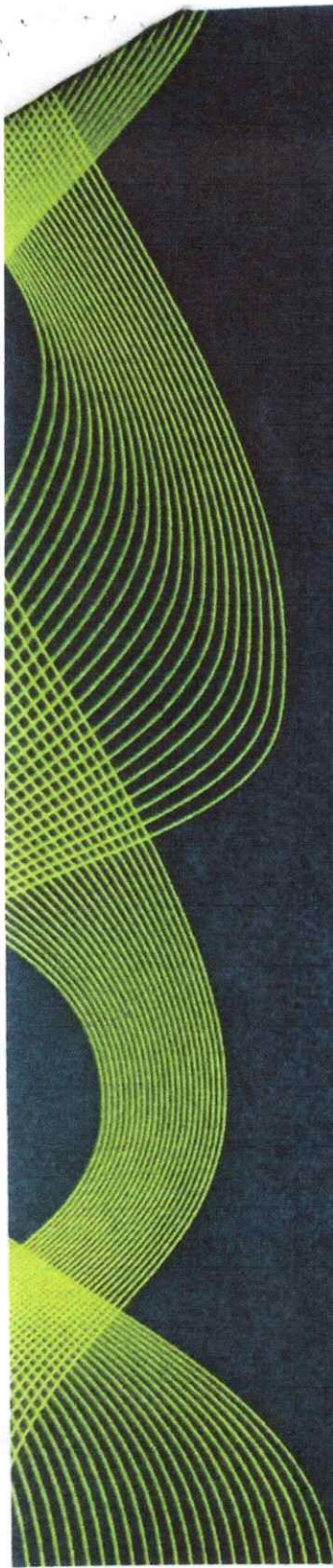

II. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

The 5th International Conference on Pedagogical Research and Innovations (5th ICPRI) of Nueva Vizcaya State University (NVSU) serves as a platform for advancing educational excellence and innovation in the Philippines. Led by the College of Teacher Education (CTE), in strategic partnership with the College of Business Education (CBE), College of Industrial Technology (CIT), College of Information Technology Education (CITE), Chao Praya University of Thailand, other international partners of the collaborating colleges, the Department of Education in Nueva Vizcaya, and other local partners, the conference builds on the success of the 4th ICPRI in 2025. The 5th ICPRI is designed to foster interdisciplinary and cross-border dialogue on pedagogical research, innovations, and transformative practices amid evolving educational landscapes shaped by digital integration, emerging information technologies, inclusivity, and sustainable development goals. The conference supports NVSU's commitment to bridging theory and practice and to empowering educators, researchers, administrators, and innovators to address emerging challenges in education, business education and industries, and information technology.

The collaborative structure of the conference brings together complementary areas of expertise. The College of Teacher Education provides a strong focus on teacher education and pedagogy; the College of Business Education contributes perspectives on entrepreneurial education and management; the College of Industrial Technology contributes technical and industry-based perspectives; and the College of Information Technology Education strengthens the integration of information technology in teaching, learning, and research. International partners contribute global perspectives, cross-cultural exchange, joint research opportunities, and innovative teaching practices, while the Department of Education provides perspectives related to basic education implementation and teacher training needs.

The conference also seeks to pursue Philippine Regulatory Commission accreditation for Continuing Professional Development units, subject to the appropriate accreditation process and

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approval. The activity is intended to support professional development and research dissemination among educators, researchers, administrators, students, and other stakeholders.

Through these collaborative and interdisciplinary approaches, the 5th ICPRI is intended to contribute to pedagogical research and innovation at NVSU and beyond by disseminating scholarly work, facilitating knowledge exchange, supporting professional development, and strengthening academic and institutional partnerships.

The 5th ICPRI aims to:

1. Foster interdisciplinary and cross-border collaboration by facilitating knowledge exchange on pedagogical and business-related research and innovations, including digital integration and emerging information technologies, that address inclusivity and sustainable education goals;

3. Pursue PRC accreditation for CPD units, subject to the applicable accreditation process and approval;
4. Promote innovative teaching strategies and diversity-inclusive, technology-supported approaches through academic and professional dialogue; and
5. Strengthen NVSU's role as a hub for pedagogical advancement by building on previous ICPRI initiatives, developing academic partnerships, and supporting forward-thinking reforms in Philippine higher education.
